This tournament (For all sections except K-12-High School) is a 7 round swiss style tournament with 4 rounds on Saturday with a time control of Game in 45 (G/45) and 3 rounds on Sunday with a time control of Game in 60 (G/60). The K-12 (High School) section will have 6 rounds with a time control of Game in 60 (G/60) with 3 rounds on Saturday and 3 rounds on Sunday. The K-12 section will also be used to choose the Denker and Polgar representatives from Arizona.

Unless otherwise covered in ACFI rules,USCF rules and scholastic guidelines will apply.

Late entries will be accepted through 9:00 Saturday April 25th. Any entries accepted on Saturday April 25th will not play in round one of the tournament (zero points).

This tournament is being organized by The Killip Chess Power Chess Club.
