So for National Chess Day we honor Steve with this tournament in his name.

Open Section: Entry Fee: \$50.00 per player with free Entries to IM's and GM's, 5SS, 20/1, SD/1. Round times: Saturday 9:00 am, 2:00 pm, 7:00 pm, Sunday 9:00 am, 2:00 pm, Awards 4:00 pm. Prize fund will be figured on 80% of the entry fees in the Open Section. 1st place - 40% of the prize fund, 2nd place - 20% of the prize fund, 3rd place - 10% of the prize fund, Best Under 2200, Best Under 1800, Best Under 1400 will be 10% of the prize fund each. Also 1st place will receive the Stubenrauch Memorial Trophy

Note: Entries from IM's and GM's will be figured into the prize fund as if they paid \$50.00 each and the entry fee will be deducted from any monetary award that they receive.

3 tournaments will be held over the weekend, all with no entry fees*

Tournament #1- Saturday non-rated beginner , K-3, K-6 sections

Tournament #2 - Saturday, rated, K-1, K-3, K-6, K-9, HS sections

Tournament #3 - Sunday, rated K-3, K-6, K-9, HS sections

Sections may be combined if deemed necessary by head TD

All Scholastic Players will receive National Chess Day Certificates and we will announce the top 10 in each section during awards at 5:00 each day

Note: Entries received on the day of the tournament are subject to a \$10.00 fee

USCF memberships is required for all players except the non-rated beginner Tournament

USCF memberships will be available at the tournament.
